



Bodies and Senses



Our Learning Focus this half term is the Body and Senses. We will be finding out about how our bodies work. We will be using 'Funnybones' to find out about the skeleton and 'Mr Jack A little dog in a big hurry' to find out about the senses. Children will have lots of opportunities to explore smell, sound and touch in different ways.



Puppet Workshop

We are very excited to be welcoming a special guest on Monday 4th July to Reception. Major Mustard will be joining us for the day to lead a Puppet Making workshop. Children will make their own puppets and perform a show using them.
