Learning Focus



Our learning focus for this half term is 'Light'. For the first two weeks, we are finding out about Bonfire Night. We are learning about Guy Fawkes and creating Bonfire Night art, poetry and stories. For the following three weeks, we will be completing our first Visual Literacy unit of the year to support our English curriculum. More details will follow soon in a very special letter! Towards the end of the term, we will be learning about different festivals of light including Diwali and Hanukkah.

Computing

In Computing, we are exploring different computer games and thinking more about algorithms and how the game maker has used them.

As part of this, we will be discussing safety to do with gaming. We will be talking about the age restriction rules for games and how the children should tell an adult if they are concerned about something on a game they are playing. It would be beneficial for you to also discuss this with your child at home, particularly if they enjoy playing computer games.
