On sunnier days, children will need a named sun-hat for outdoor play. Please ensure you apply sunscreen to your child before they come to school. If you wish to send sunscreen for your child to re-apply during the day, please ensure it is named and stored inside a plastic bag or container so it doesn't leak.

Please teach your child to re-apply sunscreen independently. There are child friendly applicator versions of many sunscreens, or brands of all day sunscreen available if this is too tricky.
