Delta Variant

Birmingham has been listed as an enhanced response area due to rising cases of the Delta variant of covid-19 across the city.

The advice is to:

- Take extra care and meet people outside, rather than inside, wherever possible
- Follow all the rules around social distancing, face coverings, washing hands, wiping surfaces and keeping windows open.
- Minimise travel into and out of the area
- Get your vaccination when it is offered to you.
- Take free twice-weekly tests (these are the lateral flow kits for people who do not have Covid symptoms). If positive, book a PCR test immediately to confirm the result.

Schools have been instructed by the Director of Public Health for the city not to hold school to school transition days and to restrict events. We are awaiting further clarification from the Local Authority.

Unfortunately this means that we will not be inviting parents to watch our Sports Days next week. The events will go ahead and each child will bring home a photograph of themselves participating.

Poetry Recital


Well done to all the Key Stage One children who took part in the poetry recital.
