


Equity & Diversity

What does this mean?



- Every child should feel seen, respected and able to succeed.
- Fair does not always mean the same. Some children need different support.
- The school values different backgrounds, cultures, languages and experiences.
- Barriers are identified and removed so all children can take part.

What can you expect?

- Children and families treated with dignity and respect
- Information is shared in languages and formats that families understand
- Learning that reflects different cultures, identities and experiences
- Reasonable adjustments made to remove barriers
- Equal access to clubs, trips and wider school opportunities
- An accessibility plan in place and reviewed regularly



How can you be involved?

- Share information about your child's background, language or experiences
- Raise concerns about fairness or inclusion
- Take part in surveys or parent forums
- Ask how the school promotes equality and representation
- Suggest ways the school could better reflect its community
